










# How Many?

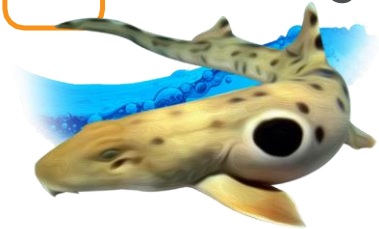
