Threats

Overfishing, around 100 million sharks are killed every year for their fins

Habitat (where they live)

They can be found in warm or temperate waters all around the world's oceans, except the eastern Pacific

Diet (what they eat)

Fish, Squid and Crustaceans

Life span (how long they live for)

15 or more years

Size:

Between 2 and 3 metres

Breeding:

Females are typically larger than males and give birth to two live young on average every two years
