Task 2

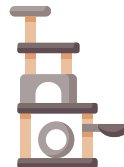

Can you match the 3 animals with the 3 different refuges they might enjoy? Draw a line to match them together!



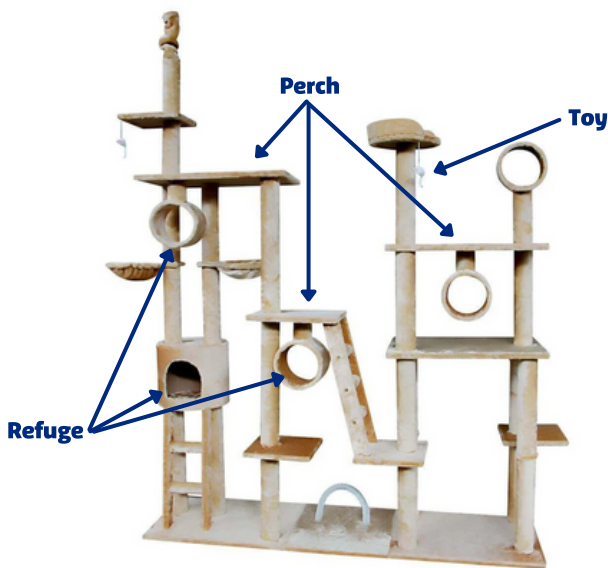
(Turn upside down for the answers!)
